BEGINNER COURSE

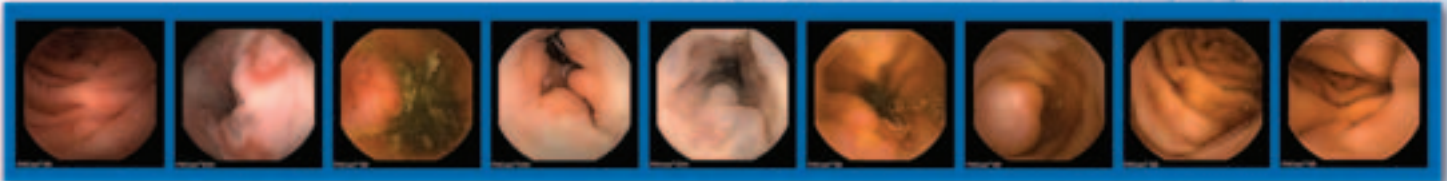
Designed for new and potential capsule users, this course provides an introduction to capsule endoscopy in clinical practice. On completion of the course, participants will be able to:
